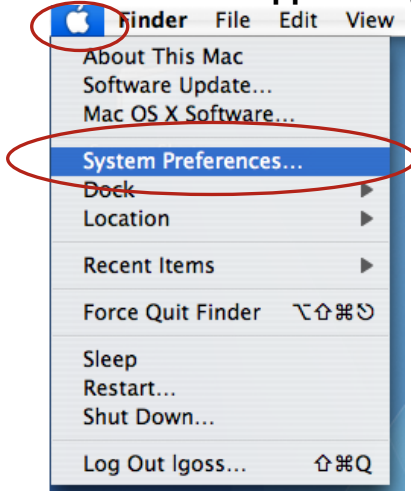


CHARACTER ACTIVATION GUIDE

Japanese – Mac OS X

To activate Japanese Characters for your Macintosh OS X system, please follow these 7 simple steps.

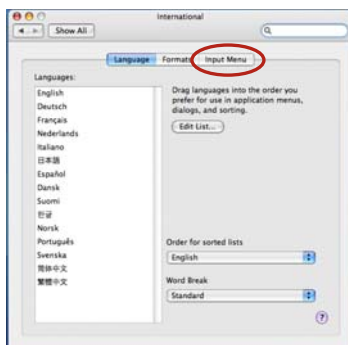
1. Start from the **Apple** and go to **System Preferences**.



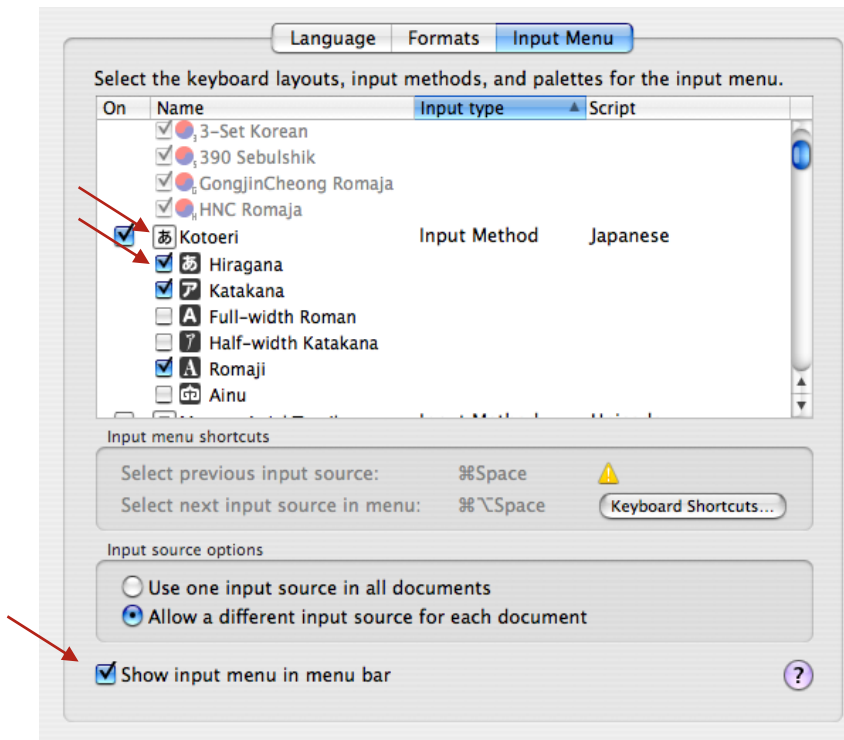
2. Click on **Language & Text** (also called **International** in earlier OS X versions).



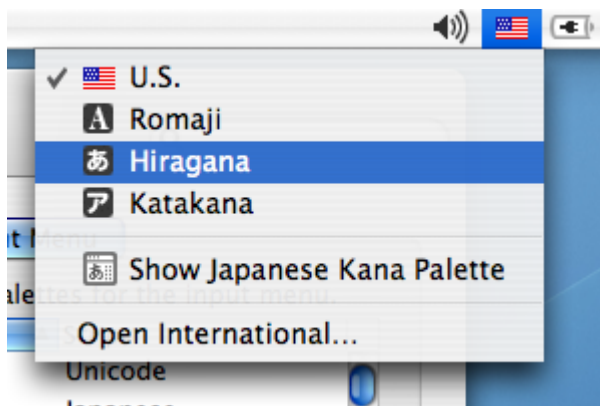
3. Click on the **Input Sources** tab (also called **Input Menu** in earlier OS X versions).



4. Select the **Kotoeri (Japanese)** input methods.
5. At the bottom, Click to select the **Show input menu in menu bar** option.



6. Click on the **flag** in the top right corner of your desktop and choose a Japanese character set, such as **Hiragana**.
